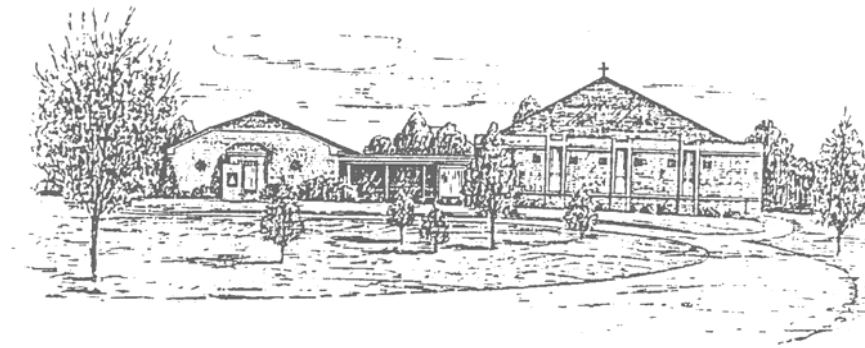

### Nursery

All children are welcome to stay with parents in the Sanctuary during worship. However, for parents of children ages 0-2.5 years who want nursery care, we have a well-equipped and professionally-staffed nursery at the end of the hall nearest the Sanctuary. Each child brought to the nursery is given a number; only the parents of the child can take the child from the nursery. If a parent is needed during worship, the child's number will appear (in red LED's) on the black panels beneath the hymn boards on both sides of the Chancel. Parents, please bring diapers and any snacks, formula as needed for your child.

### Holy Communion

All baptized Christians are welcome to receive the Sacrament. If you have not been baptized, please come to the Altar rail for a blessing during Holy Communion (place your arms across your chest to signify your desire for a blessing). If you would like to be baptized, please speak with the clergy after the service. To receive Holy Communion, accept the bread in your hand and place it in your mouth, then sip wine from the Chalice when it is brought to you (guide the Chalice to your mouth please), or hold the bread, dip it in the wine when the chalice comes to you, and place the bread with wine in your mouth. If you are allergic to wheat or are gluten intolerant, please let the person serving bread know to give you a rice wafer.

### Why Did God Give Us Renewable Energy Sources?

According to a national poll recently released by the American Wind Energy Association (AWEA), the American public supports increasing the use of wind power in the U.S. and adopting a strong Renewable Electricity Standard (RES). In fact, the poll concluded that 77 percent of Americans support a national Renewable Electricity Standard. The poll highlights that an overwhelming, bipartisan majority (89 percent) of American voters (including 84 percent of

Republicans, 88 percent of Independents and 93 percent of Democrats) believe increasing the amount of energy the nation gets from wind is a good idea. (Who would have thought!) However, the poll also noted that 56 percent of Americans disapprove of the job Congress is doing on renewable energy and 67 percent of those polled believe Congress is not doing enough to increase renewable energy sources such as wind.
